

Tour Highlights:

Our tour includes visits to several unique cities in Ghana including Accra, Ghana's vibrant and cosmopolitan capital, Cape Coast, Elmina; and the Assin Manso Slave River Site in the historic Central Region; and Kumasi, the capital of the famous Asante Empire.



DAYS 1-2:

Arrival in Ghana and Accra City Tours

We will visit Independence Square (where Ghanaians celebrate the nation's Independence Day each year); and stand under Black Star Square which is a monument to the Black Star of Ghana, which Dr. Kwame Nkrumah, Ghana's first Prime Minister adopted in tribute to Marcus Garvey.





Tour members will visit the Kwame Nkrumah Mausoleum, which is the final resting place of the first President of Ghana and one of Africa's most renowned Statesmen and Pan-Africanists; and the W.E.B. DuBois Memorial Center for Pan-African Culture, which is a research library and gallery containing the invaluable manuscripts of Dr. W.E.B. DuBois.









We will drive through the commercial districts of Accra and see the amazing development and growth of Accra; and stop at points of interest as we crisscross through Accra, one of the most vibrant and exciting cities in





DAYS 3-5:

We Tour the Central Region

Cape Coast Fetu Festival

Experience the vibrant and enchanting Fetu Festival, an exciting celebration of deep spiritual, cultural, and social significance. Immerse yourself in the pouring of libations, colorful attire, energetic drumming and dancing, and stunning kente cloths. This festival is a powerful expression of unity, pride, and rich cultural traditions.





We will visit Elmina and Cape Coast Slave Dungeons, infamous as the places where the largest number of enslaved Africans were housed before shipment to the Americas.





After the impactful tours of the slave dungeons, we will return to the hotel and change the mood with an evening of entertainment and fun with a Dinner and Cultural Dance and Drumming Performances.







DAYS 6-8:

We Tour Kumasi, and its Surrounding Towns.

On the way to Kumasi, we will stop at Assin Manso to participate in a Ceremony of Remembrance at "Slave River" where our ancestors were forced to bathe after their long march to the coast of Ghana, which could have taken as long as six months.





In Kumasi, tour members will have the opportunity to explore the capital city of the ancient Asante Kingdom and its surrounding towns and villages. We will visit Manhyia Palace, the traditional home of the Asantehene "the king of kings," the king of all the Asante.

While at Manhyia Palace, we will explore the Museum, which is filled with countless relics and artifacts that highlight the richness of the history and culture of the Asante people.





We will stop for photos at the Okomfo Anokye Monument, dedicated to the traditional priest who "conjured" from the skies the famous Golden Stool that unified the Asante people.





You will have time to browse through the National Center for Culture, see Artisans at work and browse through the shops filled with brass items, batik cloth, wood pieces, artwork, and pottery.





Visit the woodcarving village of Ahwiaa where you will see craftsmen carving wood masterpieces; Ntonso, famous for its kente and adinkra cloth; and Adanwomase, one of the most popular kente weaving villages.







Traditional Naming Ceremony

Tour members will have the opportunity to participate in a Traditional Naming Ceremony, where each tour member will be given a traditional Asante name based on his/her day of birth and welcomed into his/her "adopted" family with dance and celebration.

Travel to Accra and enjoy a free day before you travel to the US
