Tour Highlights:

Our tour includes: Visits to several unique cities in Ghana including Accra, Ghana's vibrant and cosmopolitan capital, Kumasi, the famous capital of the Asante Empire and Cape Coast, and Elmina in the historic Central Region.



DAYS 1-3:

Arrival in Ghana and Accra City Tours

After arriving in Accra, visit Independence Square (where Ghanaians celebrate the nation's Independence Day each year); and stand under Black Star Square which is a monument to the Black Star of Ghana, which Dr. Kwame Nkrumah, Ghana's first Prime Minister adopted in tribute to Marcus Garvey.



Visit the Kwame Nkrumah Mausoleum, which is the final resting place of the first President of Ghana and one of Africa's most renowned Statesmen and Pan-Africanists.



Visit the W.E.B. DuBois Memorial Center for Pan-African Culture, which is a research library and gallery containing the invaluable manuscripts of Dr. W.E.B. DuBois.



We will drive through the commercial districts of Accra and see the amazing development and growth of Accra; and stop at points of interest as we crisscross through Accra, one of the most vibrant and exciting cities in Africa.



After an exciting day of tours, we will return to the hotel for an evening of fun at our Welcome Dinner Buffet Party with cultural performances and a DJ playing your favorite tunes.



DAYS 4-6:

We Tour Kumasi, and its Surrounding Towns

Tour Members will have the opportunity to explore the capital city of the ancient Asante Kingdom and its surrounding towns and villages and visit Manhyia Palace, the traditional home of the Asantehene “the king of kings,” the king of all the Asante.

While at Manhyia Palace, explore the Museum, which is filled with countless relics and artifacts that highlight the richness of the history and culture of the Asante people.



Stop for photos at the Okomfo Anokye Monument, dedicated to the traditional priest who “conjured” from the skies the famous Golden Stool that unified the Asante people.



You will have time to browse through the National Center for Culture, see Artisans at work and browse through the shops filled with brass items, batik cloth, wood pieces, artwork, and pottery.



Visit the woodcarving village of Ahwiaa where you will see craftsmen carving wood masterpieces; Ntonso, famous for its kente and adinkra cloth; and Adanwomase, one of the most popular kente weaving villages.



Traditional Naming Ceremony

Participate in a Traditional Naming Ceremony, where you will be given a traditional Asante name based on your day of birth and welcomed into your "adopted" family with dance and celebration.



DAYS 7-8:

We Tour the Central Region

On the way to Elmina, we will stop at Assin Manso to participate in a Ceremony of Remembrance at "Slave River" where our ancestors were forced to bath after their long march to the coast of Ghana, which could have taken as long as six months.



Tour Elmina and Cape Coast Slave Dungeons, infamous as the places where the largest number of enslaved Africans were housed before shipment to the Americas.



DAY 9:

Free day to enjoy the beach

On this day, you will have a free day at the hotel to enjoy the ocean, the pool, and one of Ghana's most beautiful beaches.



In the evening, we will have our Departure Dinner, which will include cultural performances and a DJ playing your favorite dance tunes.



DAY 10:

Travel to Accra depart to the US

After breakfast we will depart for Accra. We will get back with plenty of time for last minute souvenir shopping and lunch, before we head to the airport for your check-in and departure to the US.


