DAYS 1-6:

Arrival in Brazil and Bahia City Tours

Afrocentric City Tour

This tour highlights the African intellectual and artistic contributions to Brazil. We'll drive by sites of important revolts from the past, visit the Afro Brazilian Museum and the Church of Rosário dos Pretos – a Black order established in the 18th Century.

Experience Brazil's African Religious Heritage

Today, you'll enjoy a full-day Salvador tour, visiting a Candomblé temple, exploring Orisha Lake, and stopping at the House of Yemanjá to discover Afro-Brazilian spirituality and customs.

Orishas are deities from West African spiritual traditions. Many Brazilians practice Candomblé and pray to these Orishas, preserving elements of their African religions from before slavery. We'll learn about this and more at the Afro-Brazilian Museum.



Visit a traditional temple of the African Religion (Candomblé) in Bahia. Explore the role that African Brazilian religions played in the maintenance and reconstruction of an African identity in the context of slavery and post-slavery systems.



In the afternoon, relax on "Black Beach" one of Brazil's most beautiful beaches, frequented by locals and loved by all.



Enjoy a Dinner with Balé Folclórico Show

In the evening, enjoy dinner and a show featuring Balé Folclórico, one of Brazil's top folkloric dance companies, with popular dances from Bahia's rich heritage.



Experience Zumbi Day (the Black Consciousness Day)

On this day, we will participate in the Black Consciousness Day celebration.

We will go on a Black history tour of Pelourinho which was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will learn about Zumbi dos Palmares (famous freedom fighter) and get to meet the leaders of Olodum (famous drumming / cultural group).



The day focuses on celebrating Afro-Brazilian cultural contributions, Black agency and resistance.



Witness the Boa Monte Festival

On this day, immerse yourself in the vibrant Boa Monte Festival in Cachoeira, a spirited celebration led by Black women (women of all African descent) that beautifully combines faith, tradition, and resistance in Brazil's Reconcavo region.



Experience an Afro-Carnival

Visit one of Brazil's most famous Afro-Carnival groups, and learn how they use the music as a tool of education and improvement of community life.



Stop at the Arts & Crafts Market where you will have the chance to buy the artifacts and crafts which Brazil is known for.



DAYS 7-9:

Fly to Rio de Janeiro and tour the city

We will fly to Rio de Janeiro. After you check-in to your hotel, relax, enjoy the hotel amenities, and prepare for the next day's exciting tours.

Visit Little Africa and Valongo Harbour

The city of Rio was the world's largest African slave port and market in the XIX Century. The Little African Tour in Rio covers the impact of the African diaspora through a route in the port region of Rio de Janeiro.



Spend an afternoon at Copacabana Beach

After the day's tour, you'll enjoy a free afternoon at Copacabana beach. The beach extends over 2 miles and features a boardwalk lined with beachside bars and restaurants. You can relax, swim, and enjoy plenty of beach.



In the evening, we'll dine at a vibrant Black-owned restaurant known for its delicious African-inspired dishes and stunning decor.



Visit Sugarloaf Mountain

Experience the breathtaking beauty of Sugarloaf Mountain, one of Rio de Janeiro's most iconic landmarks, offering panoramic views of the city's beaches, harbor, and surrounding mountains.



Visit Christ the Redeemer

Visit the world-famous Christ the Redeemer statue, one of the New Seven Wonders of the World, standing majestically atop Corcovado Mountain overlooking Rio de Janeiro.

This iconic monument offers spectacular panoramic views of the city and serves as a powerful symbol of faith, peace, and Brazilian culture.



Experience a Sunset Cruise

In the late afternoon, we'll meet for a sunset dinner at Solar do Unhao, a beautiful seaside venue with breathtaking views.

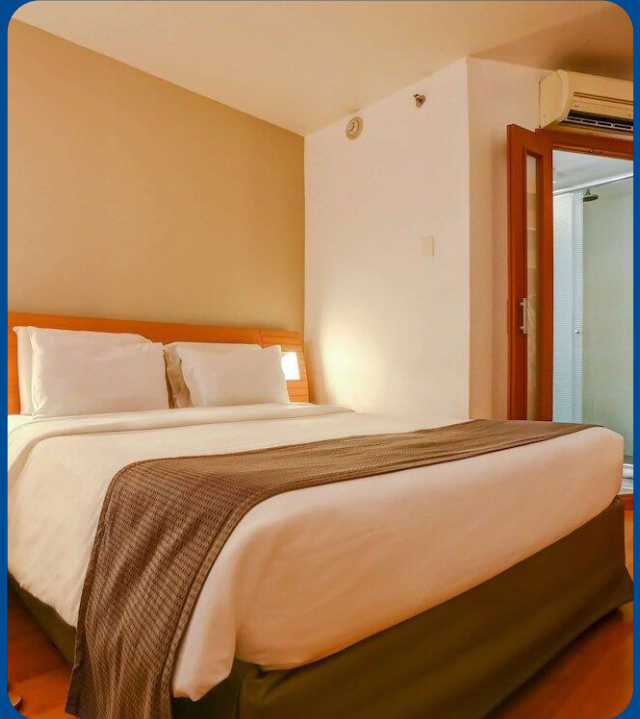


DAY 10: Departure Day
