Day 1-3	WED.-THURS. 21-23, OCT. 2026	Arrival in Cairo and city tour. Visit the Great Pyramids of Giza and get up close to the Sphinx.
Day 4-7	FRI.-SAT. 24-27, OCT. 2026	<p>Fly from Cairo to Luxor and explore the ancient temples of Karnak and Luxor, featuring colossal statues of Ramses the Great and Nefertari.</p> <p>Enjoy a 4 Day Cruise on the Nile River. Visit the ancient temples, tombs, and monuments, including the Valley of the Kings, Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, and the Colossi of Memnon.</p>
Day 8	WED. 28, OCT. 2026	Visit Abu Simbel which is carved into a mountainside by Pharaoh Ramses II.
Day 9	THURS. 29, OCT. 2026	Enjoy a free day to rest, relax, and enjoy the hotel amenities, do additional shopping, have a spa day, or do nothing at all!
Day 10	FRI. 30, OCT. 2026	Explore Nubian Egypt and its ties to ancient Black civilization. Visit the Nubian Museum.

DAYS 1-3:

Travel to Egypt and Experience the Magic of Cairo and the Pyramids

Visit the Great Pyramids, at Giza, which includes the Pyramid of Khufu, which is the largest pyramid ever built.

Walk right up and have a close look at the Sphinx, a huge funeral complex guarded by the legendary lion body with the face of King Chephren.



Visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, where over 250,000 artifacts illustrating over 5000 years of Egyptian history and art are displayed.


The exhibits at the Egyptian Museum include an exhibit dedicated to the King Tut collection of treasures. This gold and jewelry were enclosed in his tomb for over 3,500 years before it was discovered in the 1920's when his tomb was excavated.



DAYS 4:

Fly from Cairo to Luxor and Explore the Ancient Temples

Go inside the ancient Temple of Karnak and the Temple of Luxor. Stroll through the famous Temple courtyard and stand under the colossal granite statue of Ramses the Great with his queen Nefertari standing between his knees.



DAYS 5-8:

Enjoy an unforgettable Four-Day Cruise on the River Nile



See breathtaking views while you cruise on this famous ancient river.

You will be assigned comfortable rooms that will allow you to relax and enjoy this once in a lifetime experience making stops each day on the cruise at places you have only read about and seen in movies, including:

the Valley of the Kings, Nubian Egypt, the Colossi of Memnon, and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at El Deir El Bahari.





Visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu, and the Temple shared by the two gods Sobek and Haroeris. See the High Dam of Aswan and the Temple of Philae.

See the Temples of Ramses and Nefatari and tour the city built by Alexander the Great.

DAY 10:

Egypt: Land of Black Pharaohs

We visit the Nubian Museum to explore Nubian Egypt, focusing on Egypt's Black roots and its ties to Nubia.

Many historians and archaeologists argue that ancient Egypt was predominantly a Black civilization, populated by Sub-Saharan Africans. Research shows that ancient Egyptians once called the land of Egypt and the entire African continent Kemet, meaning "land of the black people."

Research also shows that many early Pharaohs were Black, with close examination of many royal mummies revealing dark brown skin tones.



DAY 11

Depart to the US
