Tour Two Regions in Ghana

Our tour includes visits to several unique cities and towns in Ghana including Accra, Ghana's vibrant and cosmopolitan capital, and Cape Coast, Elmina, Assin Manso in the historic Central Region.

DAYS 1-4:

Arrival in Ghana and Accra City Tours

Visit Independence Square in Accra, where Ghanaians celebrate Independence Day, and stand beneath the Black Star Square, a monument honoring Ghana's Black Star and Marcus Garvey, adopted by Dr. Kwame Nkrumah.

Visit the Kwame Nkrumah Mausoleum, which is the final resting place of the first President of Ghana and one of Africa's most renowned Statesmen and Pan-Africanists.



Visit the W.E.B. DuBois Memorial Center for Pan-African Culture, which is a research library and gallery containing the invaluable manuscripts of Dr. W.E.B. DuBois.

We will drive through the commercial districts of Accra and see the amazing development and growth of Accra; and stop at points of interest as we crisscross through Accra, one of the most vibrant and exciting cities in Africa.



Experience Osu Oxford Street Carnival

Wade in the water at "Slave River"

On the way to Elmina, we will stop at Assin Manso to take part in a Ceremony of Remembrance at the "Slave River", where our ancestors were made to bathe after their long and grueling march to the coast of Ghana, which could have lasted up to six months.



Experience a Traditional Naming Ceremony

Participate in a Traditional Naming Ceremony, where you will be given a traditional Asante name based on your day of birth and welcomed into your "adopted" family with dance and celebration.



Visit Elmina and Cape Coast Slave Dungeons

Tour Elmina and Cape Coast Slave Dungeons, infamous as the places where the largest number of enslaved Africans were housed before shipment to the Americas.



Relax and enjoy the beach

You will have plenty of time to enjoy the ocean, the pool, and one of Ghana's most beautiful beaches.



DAY 9:

Travel from Cape Coast to Accra

On this day we travel back to Accra. After you check back in to your hotel, enjoy a free afternoon.

For those departing early in the morning, we will try to arrange a breakfast box.

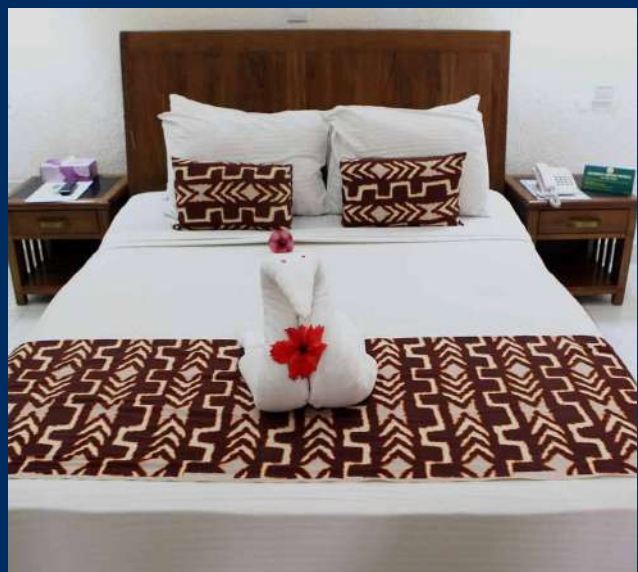
