

Day 1-5	FRI-TUES 4-8 JUNE	Arrival in Johannesburg and city tour. Explore South Africa's history and culture through visits to the Apartheid Museum, Constitution Hill, Soweto, Mandela House, and the Hector Pieterse Museum, enjoy a Big Five safari in Pilanesberg National Park, experience traditions at Lesidi Cultural Village, and end with an optional evening of live jazz, fine dining, and local wines.
Day 6-8	WED-FRI 9-11 JUNE	We will travel to Cape Town to explore Table Mountain, tour historic District Six, visit Robben Island to see Nelson Mandela's prison cell, and enjoy an evening of African drumming, dinner, and live jazz.
Day 9	SAT 12 JUNE	Fly back to Johannesburg and unwind with hotel amenities, a spa day, or simply relax before your departure.
Day 10	SUN 13 JUNE	This is departure day. For early departures, we'll try to arrange for a breakfast box. For evening flights, we'll try for the latest possible check-out time to allow you time to relax and enjoy the hotel's amenities before heading to the airport, where we will assist you with the departure procedures.

# **Travel to Johannesburg, and explore the sites**

## **Visit the Apartheid Museum**

The Apartheid Museum in Johannesburg offers a powerful glimpse into South Africa's history of racial segregation and the fight for freedom. Through impactful exhibits featuring photographs, artifacts, and personal stories, the museum chronicles the harsh realities of apartheid and the nation's courageous struggle for equality.

A visit provides a deeper understanding of the resilience that shaped modern South Africa, making it a must-see for anyone looking to connect with the country's past.



## **Visit Constitution Hill**

We will travel to Constitution Hill in Johannesburg which is a historic site that embodies South Africa's journey from oppression to democracy. It was once a prison that held notable figures like Nelson Mandela and Mahatma Gandhi, it now houses the country's highest court, the Constitutional Court.

The site's exhibits share stories of the struggle for freedom and the resilience of those who fought against apartheid. A visit to Constitution Hill offers a compelling look at the nation's challenging past.



## Soweto Tour

Soweto (South Western Townships) was the epicenter of the anti-apartheid struggle, and today, it stands as a symbol of resilience and hope.

The tour will provide insights into South Africa's political history and urban culture with opportunities to engage with local residents and experience the unique energy of Soweto.



## Visit the Mandela House

You will have the opportunity to visit the Mandela House, which is a national heritage site and museum dedicated to the life of Nelson Mandela, South Africa's first black president.

This was Mandela's home from 1946 until the 1990s, although much of that time was spent in prison. Today, it houses exhibitions of Mandela's personal memorabilia, historical artifacts, and photographs that tell the story of his fight against apartheid.



## Tour the Hector Pieterse Museum

The Hector Pieterse museum is located in Orlando West, Soweto. It is two blocks away from where student protester Hector Pieterse was shot and killed on 16 June 1976.

The museum is named in his honour and covers the events of the anti-Apartheid Soweto Uprising, where more than 170 protesting school children were killed.

Tour members will have the opportunity to explore the museum's films, newspapers, personal accounts and photographs, the most famous being the iconic photo by Sam Nzima below.



## Explore the Pilanesberg National Park

Pilanesberg National Park is possibly South Africa's most fascinating game reserve. Situated in the ecologically rich transition zone between the Kalahari and the Lowveld, this vast area promises thrilling big-game viewing.

Pilanesberg is home to more than 7,000 animals, including the Big 5 and 360 species of birds, and promises thrilling game viewing.



## Visit Lesidi Cultural Village

The Lesidi Cultural Village celebrates the cultural traditions of several different peoples of Southern Africa.

Your visit begins with a multi-sensory presentation of the origins of South Africa's indigenous inhabitants, followed by a guided walk through actual tribal homesteads.



Witness the Lesedi Cultural Ingoma Dance, performed through choreographed movement, beating drums and songs.



## Have an Optional Jazz Night outing

Enjoy a soulful evening with live jazz and fine dining at one of the city's top jazz lounges. Savor delicious local cuisine and wines as smooth melodies fill the air.






The area was declared a “white-only” area in 1966. This Museum recalls the once-vibrant, racially diverse suburb that existed before its destruction under apartheid.

## Visit Robben Island Museum

Take a boat ride to Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for 18 of the 27 years of his imprisonment before the fall of apartheid. Mandela and several other anti-apartheid activists were imprisoned in Robben Islands' maximum-security prison in 1964, living in brutal conditions until the end of apartheid in 1994.



A visit to Robben Island should be a “Must See” stop on any tour of South Africa. See the actual cell where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned. This tour gives you a tangible connection to his story and a powerful glimpse into a dark period of history.
