DAYS 1-2: **Accra City Tours**

Visit Independence Square in Accra, where Ghanaians celebrate Independence Day, and stand beneath the Black Star Square, a monument honoring Ghana's Black Star and Marcus Garvey, adopted by Dr. Kwame Nkrumah.

Visit the Kwame Nkrumah Mausoleum, which is the final resting place of the first President of Ghana and one of Africa's most renowned Statesmen and Pan-Africanists.



Visit the W.E.B. DuBois Memorial Center for Pan-African Culture, which is a research library and gallery containing the invaluable manuscripts of Dr. W.E.B. DuBois.

We will drive through the commercial districts of Accra and see the amazing development and growth of Accra; and stop at points of interest as we crisscross through Accra, one of the most vibrant and exciting cities in Africa.



Visit the Arts Centre in Accra, which is a lively hub for Ghanaian culture, offering handmade crafts, textiles, and artwork by local artisans. It's the perfect spot to pick up authentic souvenirs.



DAYS 3-4:

We Tour the Central Region

Wade in the water at "Slave River"

On the way to Elmina, we will stop at Assin Manso to take part in a Ceremony of Remembrance at the "Slave River", where our ancestors were made to bathe after their long and grueling march to the coast of Ghana, which could have lasted up to six months.



Visit Elmina and Cape Coast Slave Dungeons

Tour Elmina and Cape Coast Slave Dungeons, infamous as the places where the largest number of enslaved Africans were housed before shipment to the Americas.



In the evening, we will have our Farewell Dinner, which will include cultural drumming and dancing performances.



DAY 5:

Free morning then travel to Accra

On this day, you will have a free morning at the hotel to enjoy the ocean, the pool, and one of Ghana's most beautiful beaches, before we head back to Accra where you'll have time to enjoy the hotel amenities, do additional shopping, or relax and do nothing at all.
