DAY 3:

Visit Jozani Forest

Jozani forest and Ngezi nature reserves are the centre of biodiversity in Zanzibar. Jozani forest is the largest area of mature forest left on the island. It is also host to the endangered Zanzibar Red Colobus monkey, several species of butterflies, about 40 species of birds and several other animals.



Visit Zanzibar Land Animals Park

After Jozani Forest, continue to ZALA Park. ZALA (Zanzibar Land Animals) Park was founded as a project to help local people appreciate the value of wildlife, with funds raised by tourist visits. The park itself appears forlorn today, as

In the evening, we will join the Sauti za Busara festival concert. Sauti za Busara literally means the sounds of wisdom in Swahili. Is the only Tanzania music festival that holds movers and shakers sessions to showcase the rich African and Swahili music.



DAY 4:

Visit the Slave Market

The Slave Market of Stone Town has been inactive for decades, but memorials provide a stark reminder of the horrific acts that once took place here.

Visit this site and reflect on the atrocities of the past as you stand in the shadow of the Anglican Church. Learn about the important role slavery played in Zanzibar's history.



Shop at the community market in Fumba Town

Visit Prison Island

Prison Island: Prison Island, also known as Changuu Island was left untouched until it was inhabited by the Arabs in the 1860's. The island was used as a temporary shelter for slaves who were considered rebellious or with potential to lead revolts.

The slaves were kept there before being sold abroad. The Island was also used to quarantine those who got sick during yellow fever epidemics.



In the evening, enjoy a free afternoon to enjoy the beach and the hotels amenities. Relax and refresh to prepare for the last and biggest night of the Sauti za Busara festival.
